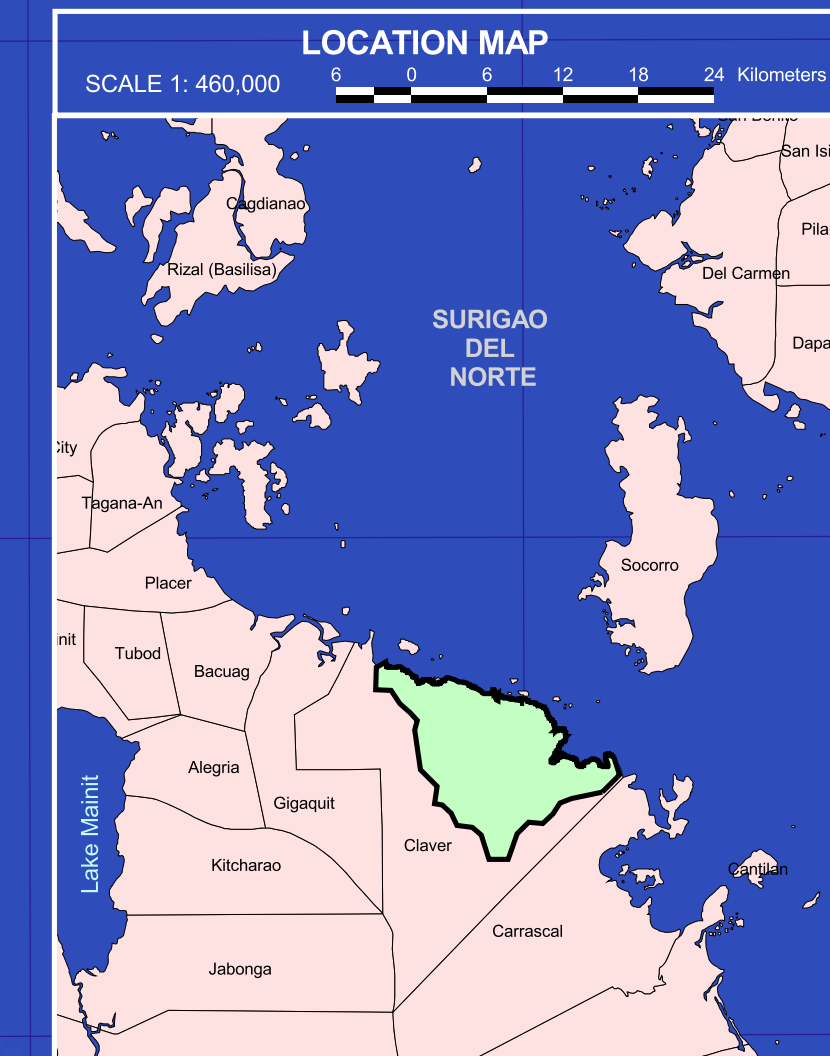
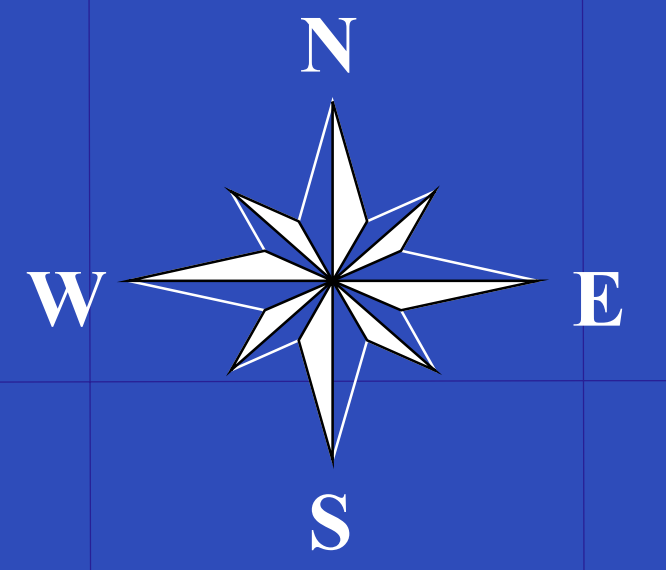


Present Land-use Map of Taganito Tribal Community (TTC)
